2.	Industry impact	In 250 words or less, demonstrate how your PhD will impact the Australian grains industry and contribute to grower profitability.
3.	Student academic record and research ability	Attach a copy of the most recent academic record. In 250 words or less explain why you believe you have the potential to be a successful GRS scholar.
4.	Supervisor track record	In 250 words or less explain why the supervisory team has the expertise and experience to successfully supervise a GRS scholar. Supervisor track record does not need to be in grains related research, but if not should explain how the supervisory team can help the student deliver impact for the grains industry.

Summary

Short summary of the research proposal. To be written in plain English for public release.

Rationale and Background

You may provide a *brief* rationale for the proposed research topic, up to 250 words.

Methodology

Not required.

A detailed methodology is not required during the initial application stage. In the initial application we are expecting high-level (not detailed) proposals that will be further developed in consultation with the student, supervisor, and GRDC if the applicant is successful.

Delivery Pathway

Not required.

Delivery pathway is not required at the initial application stage.

Capability Statement *

Brief statement explaining you have the capability to complete the proposed PhD research as described in the evaluation criteria.

Proposed Contract Personnel *

Note: You cannot deactivate an Applicant, and any personnel listed here will have access to details of this application.
